Footing Inspection: Bottom of trench **PRIOR** to the pouring of concrete

Foundation Inspection: **PRIOR** to the placement of backfill

Foundation Location Survey must be submitted immediately after foundation inspection.

Framing Inspection: **AFTER** passing rough electric and plumbing inspections and **BEFORE** insulation

Insulation Inspection: **PRIOR** to placement of gypsum board

Final Building Inspection: **MAY** be scheduled with final electric, fire and plumbing inspections

*** The scope of work on every job is different, therefore, not all of the above inspections may be necessary for your project. If you are unsure, consult with your contractor or Sub-code Official prior to calling in for an inspection.**
