

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A CONTRACT TO BAYSHORE RECYCLING, CORP.**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Livingston has an immediate need for a firm to market its recyclable materials collected from the Township of Livingston's recycling program that cannot otherwise be performed by its regular employees; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 29, 2017, the Township of Livingston issued RFP No. 16-2017 as a fair and open process in accordance with N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5 et seq, to solicit proposals from recycling brokers, processors and end-users experienced in marketing recyclable materials collected from established recycling programs; and

**WHEREAS**, the request for proposals ("RFP") was advertised in the West Essex Tribune and on the Township of Livingston website on June 29, 2017, and as a result twelve (12) rfp packages were requested; and

**WHEREAS**, on July 26, 2017, three (3) proposals were received by the rfp deadline and publicly read; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with the selection criteria established in the rfp, the proposals were evaluated for understanding of the requested work, types of materials collected, management, experience and personnel qualifications, and price; and


**WHEREAS**, Bayshore Recycling, Corp. submitted a proposal that meets all of the requirements of the RFP specifications, complies with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.S.A. 17:27 et seq., and is the most advantageous to the Township; and


**WHEREAS**, the Acting Township Manager recommends the award of a contract to Bayshore Recycling, Corp. for a period of one (1) year, with an option to renew for two (2) one (1) year extensions at the sole discretion of the Township; and


**WHEREAS**, the income derived from Bayshore Recycling Corp.'s marketing effort (calculated from the Township's 2016 annual tonnage report) will result in potential monthly income to the Township of \$19,093.95 based upon market prices and a minimum monthly income of \$11,315.40 based upon guaranteed floor prices; and

**WHEREAS**, Bayshore Recycling, Corp.'s schedule of pricing is attached; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Township Council of the Township of Livingston, in the County of Essex, State of New Jersey, that it authorizes the Acting Township Manager to enter into a contract with Bayshore Recycling, Corp. effective November 1, 2017 for the marketing of its recyclable materials.
